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HAUL ROUTES FOR GRADING PROJECTS

References: City of Irvine Municipal Code Sections 5-10-127, 6-3-565 through 6-3-569;
Grading Manual Section 5.3, a.7.

Haul Routes For Grading Projects

Prior to commencing any grading project for which the import and/or export of earth materials exceeds 5,000 cubic yards, a haul route is required to be approved by the Grading and Right-of-way inspector on behalf of the Chief Building Official. Haul routes are required to utilize designated truck routes. Any proposed route should contemplate other known activities, such as road work or other construction sites that may compound traffic impacts.

Designated truck routes are defined in Municipal Code Section 6-3-565. Weight restricted streets limited to maximum vehicle gross weights of 7 or 3 tons are defined in Municipal Code Section 6-3-567. The attachment depicts these routes and restricted streets.


Prior to commencing the work, but no later than the pre-grade meeting, the proposed haul route must be reviewed and approved by the City Grading and Right-of-Way Inspector. The contractor is required to provide the following information:

- Proposed route
- Anticipated vehicle gross weights
- Anticipated schedule including overall duration, and haul hours of operation.

Revisions to approved routes may be required, at the discretion of the Chief Building Official, should impacts to the community or the driving public warrant such revisions.
