2019 Spring ADULT SOCCER REGISTRATION INFORMATION

The Community Services Department is currently accepting applications for the Spring 2019 Adult Soccer League. All leagues will play a ten (10) week season. Irvine soccer leagues are governed by FIFA rules, except as modified by City of Irvine League By-Laws. For a complete copy of the League By-Laws please see our [website](#) or call: (949) 724-6825.

Deadline: Monday, January 14 at 5:30pm for all 7v7 leagues

Teams that register after the deadline will be placed on a waiting list and added if there is space available.

Teams must have a paid receipt from Bill Barber Community Park by the above date and time. If mailing your registration materials, please ensure we receive your registration packets by the deadline date. Items received in the mail after the deadline period will be considered late.

The season is scheduled to start on the following dates. Dates are subject to change:

*No teams are officially registered until notified by the league office. Space is limited and not all teams that register will be admitted into the league. All teams have an equal chance of admittance if roster, payment, and verification materials are turned in before the end of registration. Any teams that sign up AFTER the deadline will be admitted on a first come, first served basis provided there is still space.

*Please do not purchase player ID cards until notified by the league office that your team was admitted.

*The league office will attempt to notify all team managers by January 17, 2018 if they have been

admitted. Admittance is based off our point system described on pages #2 & 3.

I. Procedure to enter a team:

- A. The team roster, team questionnaire, league fees and point verification information are all due by the registration deadline.

League Fees:	7v7 Leagues - \$645 per team (10 games) 11v11 Leagues - \$1495 per team
Player ID Cards:	Player ID Cards \$10 per person. Photos can be obtained 10am-7pm at Bill Barber Community Park, Monday through Thursday, and 10am-5:30pm Fridays

- B. Please make a check payable to "City of Irvine". Only one (1) personal check per team. Please write team name in the memo line of the check
- C. Visa, Discover, American Express, and MasterCard are also acceptable forms of payment.
- D. Rosters must be submitted on an official City of Irvine Spring 2019 Soccer Roster or an exact replica.
- E. All applications received after the deadline will be put on a waiting list and will be admitted if space is available.
- F. Teams that do not qualify for placement in the league will be notified and issued a full refund.
- G. **Teams who qualify and are placed in the league will have until the 3rd game to pay the full**

season fee.

- H. Any team that wishes to withdraw after having submitted their roster and fee will be subject to the following penalty schedule:

On or before January 14	No Penalty
On or after January 15	Full Fee

2. Team priority for league selections is done through the point verifications system outlined below:

All applications that we receive by the deadline will be prioritized according to our point system. Two points are awarded for every verified Irvine resident and one point is credited for every player who verifies Irvine employment. For 7v7 rosters, we allow 12 players to be considered for the point verification system and for 11v11 rosters, we allow 18 players to be considered for the point verification system. To receive credit for points, manager must submit verification information for each player who lives or works in Irvine.

- A. To verify Irvine residence, we will accept:
- A recent copy of a utility bill with the player's name and Irvine address. One bill may be used for one or more players with the same last name living at the same address.
 - We will not credit points for an item with a handwritten address, a bill that is more than three months old, an address printed on a check, or a driver's license.
- B. To verify employment, we will accept the following documents:
- A computer printout from Human Resources or other administrative divisions with players' names, employee numbers, and the printout date. Any financial information may be whitened or blacked out. This option is only available to teams that have at least three players working for the same company.
 - A paycheck stub from October, November, or December with player's name, date, company name and company's Irvine address. If the Irvine address is not on the check stub, then the player must also provide some documentation of the company's Irvine address, ideally on company letterhead. Any financial information may be whitened or blacked out. Please submit copies only.
 - For those who are self-employed, we will accept a copy of a current business license. For students we will accept a student ID. For people who work in their home while not on any company's payroll, we will not be awarding employment points because they are not further contributing to the tax base. (Naturally, they will receive their 2 points for being a resident).
- C. All verification information must be submitted with team roster and league fee as a team package. No individual submittals will be accepted.
- D. All photocopied information will be destroyed after points have been verified, and teams will not receive this information back.

3. Eligibility:

- Players must be at least eighteen (18) years of age on or before they enter a game.
- A maximum of two women may be placed on the roster of a Men's team.
- Players may not play on more than one team in the same league.

- D. All players must have their Player ID card at all games.
- E. No men may be placed on a roster for a women's team.

4. Rosters:

- A. Each team shall submit an official completed roster of no more than twelve (12) players for 7v7 teams and no more than eighteen (18) players for 11v11 teams. All participants must purchase their Player ID cards to play. All players will be required to sign their team roster on the field. In the event that a player wishes to be added to an additional team/roster after they have purchased their Player ID card, they must report to the park where they play to sign the team roster. All players have to sign the team roster on the field they play at.
- B. Roster Additions may be made up until the start of your seventh league game. Roster additions should be emailed to MSoto@cityofirvine.org. There are no roster deletions allowed. A 7v7 team may have a maximum of 22 players and an 11v11 team may have a maximum of 25 players. If the new team member does not possess a Player ID card they will be required to acquire one before their game. All players need to sign the official team roster located at their field.

5. Scheduling guidelines for all leagues:

- **All 7v7 game times are an even distribution of 7:40 and 8:50pm start times
- **11v11 Men's game times are an even distribution of 7:15pm, 8:00pm, and 9:00pm
- **11v11 Coed game times are an even distribution of 9:30am, 11:15am, and 1:00 p.m.
