NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Special Municipal Election will be held in the City of Irvine on Tuesday, June 5, 2018, for the following questions to be submitted to the qualified voters of the City:

Shall Ordinance No. 17-08, approving a zone text amendment so as to facilitate the development of the Southern California Veterans Cemetery by reflecting an exchange of City-owned property for the State-approved site at the intersection of Bake Parkway and Interstate 5, commonly known as Strawberry Fields, be adopted? Shall the measure amending the Irvine City Charter to require at least a two-thirds vote of the total City Council membership in order to place City Council sponsored general or special tax proposals on a ballot for voter consideration, be adopted?	YES
