There is an error on the Sample and Absentee Ballots for the November 2, 2004 election. Instructions **incorrectly** tell voters to "vote for no more than two (2)" in the Irvine City Council contest.

CORRECT INSTRUCTIONS: CAST NO MORE THAN THREE (3) VOTES for the "Office of Irvine City Council"

If you are an Absentee Ballot Voter it is important to...



Vote the regular Absentee Ballot you received (or will receive) from the Registrar's Office

- ✓ Vote as instructed on your Absentee Ballot.
- Your vote for "Office of Irvine Mayor" will be counted on this ballot.
- Your vote for "Office of Irvine City Council" will not be counted on this ballot.



## Vote the Supplemental Absentee Ballot you will receive

- Vote for no more than three (3) candidates for the "Office of Irvine City Council."
- ✓ This vote will be counted.
- You will not be able to vote for the "Office of Irvine Mayor" on this ballot.



## Return your ballots

- Ballots must be returned separately in the envelopes provided by the Registrar's office.
- Ballots must reach the Registrar by November 2, 8 p.m.

## If You Vote at a Polling Location ...

Ballot instructions at polling locations will correctly instruct you to cast **no more than three (3)** votes for the "Office of Irvine City Councilmember."
