BUILDING AND SAFETY CURB ADDRESS PAINTING

1. City Encroachment and Business Permits are required prior to commencement of any work.
2. Applicant is required to obtain written consent from the Village Community Association in which work is proposed. If there is no Village Association, approval signatures from all residents is required. Such content is required to be submitted to the City. The forms being distributed by the applicant to the community for donations shall be reviewed for discretionary approval by the City.
3. PAINTING APPLICATION STANDARD
 - a. The curb shall be thoroughly cleaned prior to painting.
 - b. A good quality white flat epoxy paint shall be used which shall cover the previous number and background without detection of the old addressing, and extend one-half inch beyond the number (see example).
 - c. A good quality black epoxy paint shall be used for the numerals and applied only after the white base has been given ample drying time. Numerals shall be four-inch gothic or block style.
 - d. Applicant shall contact City's Building and Safety Inspection Section (714) 724-6500 prior to commencement of proposed work.
 - e. The Encroachment Permit may be revoked at any time that the City inspector finds that the permittee fails to comply with this standard and/or violates any City ordinance or condition itemized on the Encroachment Permit. If the permit is revoked, the applicant shall discontinue all operations and restore the City right-of-way as directed.
