HEADROOM CLEARANCE OF PARKING FACILITIES LOCATED IN THE BASEMENT OR FIRST STORY OF A BUSINESS OR RESIDENTIAL BUILDING WHERE ACCESSIBILITY TO HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACE IS NOT REQUIRED.

A minimum headroom clearance of not less than 7 feet 6 inches above the finished floor to any ceiling, beam, pipe or similar construction is required to accommodate the mail delivery vehicles in the City of Irvine.

The Manager of Customer Service, Irvine Post Office, has requested the City's assistance in establishing mail delivery for new developments in Irvine by providing a minimum garage headroom clearance of 7 feet 6 inches.

Effective immediately, all building permit applicants will be advised of this headroom clearance requirement through the plan review process. Any headroom clearance less than this minimum must be reviewed and accepted by the postal service.

Where accessibility to handicapped/physically disabled parking space is required by the California State Accessibility Standards, the minimum vertical clearance will be 8 feet 2 inches.

UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE HEADROOM REQUIREMENT

Regarding: Parking Garage Headroom
Headroom Clearance

Parking Garage Headroom:

In order for the Postal Service to deliver to any subterranean parking structure/mailroom location, an unobstructed headroom clearance of not less than 7 feet, 6 inches is needed above the finished floor to any ceiling, beam, pipe or similar construction.

Headroom Clearance:

The Postal Service vehicles shall have an unobstructed headroom clearance of not less than 7 feet, 6 inches above the finished floor to any ceiling beam, pipe or similar construction in order to provide a delivery service to the occupant(s) of your project.
