2. FISCAL YEAR 2011-12 FEBRUARY BUDGET UPDATE

Lori Fisher, Senior Management Analyst, presented the staff report and answered questions.

Commission discussion included: sales tax and vehicle fees; control of contract services; extending reduction of expenses into the future; unfilled positions vs. level of services; and Public Safety recruitment for vacant positions.

Recommend that the City Council receive and file the Fiscal Year 2011-12 February Budget Update.

3. BOND ISSUANCE FOR REASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 04-20 GROUP TWO

Valaya Chitchakkol, Finance Administrator, presented the staff report and answered questions. Paul Pender, Vice President of Fieldman Rolapp & Associates, was also present to answer questions.

Commission discussion included: breakdown of savings; debt service; City's role in the reassessment process; clarification of conflict of interest for Commissioners; undeveloped part of reassessment area; and types of structures being reassessed.

Recommend the City Council adopt A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IRVINE AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE AND SALE OF NOT TO EXCEED \$8,000,000 AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF CITY OF IRVINE REASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 04-20 LIMITED OBLIGATION IMPROVEMENT BONDS, GROUP TWO APPROVING THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF A FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL INDENTURE, AND A BOND PURCHASE AGREEMENT
