 Senior Services Strategic Plan Update – Sheila Driscoll, Superintendent

Superintendent Driscoll stated the Senior Services Strategic Plan was approved by the City Council at its May 8 meeting. A final copy of the plan was distributed to Councilmembers.

Senior Services Donor Open House – Lynne Conger, Supervisor

Supervisor Conger stated the Community Partner Open House for members of the business community will be held May 24 from 11:30 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. at Lakeview Senior Center. Facility Committee Recommendations – Ed Kaleikini, Supervisor

Supervisor Kaleikini stated staff will provide a presentation of the recommended facility updates at Lakeview and Rancho Senior Centers at the June 21 Senior Citizens Council meeting. Health and safety issues are the committee's first priority when considering facility needs.

1. Senior Services Support/Interest Groups

A. Irvine Adult Day Health Services – Kimberly Beeson, Executive Director

Director Beeson provided the following information:

- Staff is working with clients to continue the transition from Medi-Cal portion of the program to the new Community Based Adult Services program;
- At this time 49 participants seniors in the Community Based Adult Services program are covered through Medi-Cal;
- Facility upgrades include new chairs and new dining room tables:
- Another Brain Fitness computer was donated to the center;

- The wine-pull fund raiser event held on April 19 at Atria Woodbridge raised \$2,200 which will go toward the purchase of a new piece of equipment;
- Sunrise donated \$200 to go toward the purchase of a new piece of gym equipment – still need \$1,700 to purchase the equipment; and
- Friends of Outreach donated \$1,000 to Irvine Adult Day Health Services.
- B. Irvine Evergreen Chinese Senior Association Clara Lin, President

Chair Wong reported elections will be held at the next meeting, no program scheduled.

C. Irvine Multicultural Association – Maria Yousef, President

The next movie presentation is "Children of Heaven" on June 6 from 5 – 7:30 p.m. at Lakeview Senior Center.

D. Friends of Outreach – Jan Owens, President

President Owens reported the following:

- The Cookie Lee fundraiser event held on Friday, June 11 raised \$210;
- A fundraiser will be held at Mimi's restaurant on Wednesday, June 13;
- Friends of Outreach will participate in the Community Partner Open House scheduled for Thursday, May 24;
- Friends of Outreach donated \$1,000 to Irvine Adult Day Health Services and \$2,500 to Senior Services for special needs; and

Vice Chair Pfeiffer distributed an article regarding intergenerational housing in Irvine.

Member Jacobs reported it was announced at the Housing/Transportation Committee meeting that funding for housing has already been distributed and houses purchased. No further details were provided.

Chair Wong stated individuals in Mission Viejo can now utilize a program called "Second Stop" which allows individuals to take a cab to a destination and the cab will wait 20 minutes for the person without charging them an extra fee.
