SUBCOMMITTEE REPORTS

Community Awareness

Boardmember Drayer shared the subcommittee's idea of implementing a community award program for Irvine businesses that employ persons with disabilities and/or support persons with special needs. The qualifying criteria for this program will be discussed further at next month's meeting.

Independent Living

Boardmember St. Amant provided an overview of the subcommittee's discussion of factors needed to support the independence for persons with disabilities. Each subcommittee member provided input on their personal needs as well as obtaining information from the disabled community. Factors identified were; accessible and affordable housing, reliable caregivers, transportation, home modifications, support systems, meals, accessible medical offices and lodging for travel.
