# 3. TREASURER'S ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 2012

Michele Lund, Irvine City Treasurer, presented the staff report and answered questions.

### 5. BUDGET ADJUSTMENT TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM PROJECTS

Alfonso Gomez, Management Analyst 1, presented the staff report and answered questions. Katie Berg-Curtis was also present and answered questions.

Commission discussion included: increase in maintenance costs; acceleration of other scheduled projects; source for moving funds to other projects; matching funds; timelines for use of funds; and funding of five additional projects with grant funds for fiscal year 2012-2013.

Recommend the City Council approve a Budget Adjustment to accept grant funds and matching fund contributions from the cities of Newport Beach and Tustin and establish Capital Improvement Program project accounts.
