Burglars often choose the garage door to gain entry to a home because it is usually the weakest, and therefore the easiest, point of entry. Once inside, burglars know to look in cars for electronic devices and other personal belongings. Becoming a burglary victim can leave a family feeling vulnerable and violated.

REDUCE THE RISK OF BECOMING A VICTIM

Close and lock your garage door if you are not present. It only takes a moment for a thief to make off with valuable property.

- ★ Lock all doors leading into your garage.
- ★ Make it a habit to remove valuables sight. Lock car doors even when the garage is closed.
- ★ Keep garage door openers on key rings. Do not leave them inside the car.
- ★ When purchasing a remote opener, consider one with a "rolling code". The changing code will prevent thieves from being able to use a captured code to open the door.
- ★ Lock bicycles even inside the garage. Use as much of the bicycle in the lock as possible, not just the front wheel.
- * Register your bike with the Irvine PD.
- ★ Inventory your belongings. Use photographs and record model and serial numbers.
- ★ Change door locks when moving into a new residence. Previous owners and tenants may not have kept track of the keys.
- ★ Look out for your neighbors. Notify your neighbors if they leave their garage door open.
- Report suspicious behavior immediately
