The City of Irvine, in partnership with Vietnam Veterans of America and Vision2Victory, is proud to welcome *The Wall That Heals*, a traveling replica of the Vietnam Veterans Memorial in Washington, D.C. and the Global War on Terror Wall of Remembrance.

A half-scale replica of the original Memorial that rests in Washington, D.C., The Wall That Heals tours communities throughout the United States, allowing the souls enshrined on the Memorial to exist once more among family and friends in the peace and comfort of familiar surroundings.

The Global War on Terror Wall of Remembrance memorializes the two million veterans and civilians involved in the Global War on Terror. This is the first time these two memorial walls will appear together.

Under the supervision of volunteers, both memorials will remain open for public viewing 24 hours a day from July 18-21.
