# 1. Senior Services Support/Interest Groups

A. Irvine Adult Day Health Services

Executive Director Kimberly Beeson reported that the program census has been down due to an unusual number of recent discharges. Participants continue to benefit from services and the center continues to receive volunteer support. Positions are in the process of being filled; two Certified Nurse Assistant positions and a Program Director position. The fourth annual Take a Chance for Seniors Casino Night is scheduled for Saturday, October 5, 2013 from 5:30-10 p.m. at a cost of \$90 per person.

B. Irvine Evergreen Chinese Senior Association

Chair Wong announced the Galaxy Youth Orchestra will provide entertainment at the August 17, 2013 meeting.

C. Irvine Multicultural Association

Councilmember Jacobs and Co-chair Yousef reported the August event was well attended. The group is engaged with Global Village planning and preparation.
