BOARDMEMBER UPDATES

Housing Task Force

- Boardmember Harvey provided the following:
 - The Housing Task Force for the Developmentally Disabled held a Community Forum on Tuesday, January 21, 2014. Approximately 100 Irvine residents were in attendance. Testimonials shared included: housing models from other cities and states; suggestions and challenges for meeting housing needs of individuals with developmental disabilities; the need for a community center in Irvine to serve individuals with disabilities.
 - Request made for staff to provide the Board with information about available services in the community.
- Boardmembers Harvey and Jewell inquired about housing guidelines for individuals receiving Social Security and/or Supplemental Security Income (SSI). Staff will coordinate a presentation on the topic at a future meeting.

Community Services Supervisor Blanco reported on the following:

- Disability Services and TRIPS Program Coordinator positions are still in the recruiting process.
- Revised IRDAB Bylaws regarding boardmember terms will be going to the Community Services Commission for approval, date to be determined.

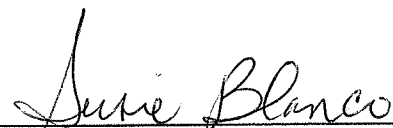
