ANNOUNCEMENTS

1. Child Care Needs Assessment

Supervisor Stubbler announced the City's request for proposals for a Nexus study to measure the impact of development on child care. The request has been proposed to five firms, the deadline to submit proposal is May 22, 2014. The Nexus study will assess the child care need based on new development.

2. Child Creativity Lab

Supervisor Stubbler introduced the Child Creativity Lab (CCL), a specialty children's museum aimed to nurture the creative mindset of children and raising their potential for personal development and contributions to society. CCL is currently introducing activities for afterschool programs and camps to encourage creativity and hands on learning. CCL is set to open in 2017 and currently looking for facilities to accommodate design plans for the museum.

3. Recap of Dr. Laura Markham Presentations

Supervisor Stubbler provided summary of two workshops presented by Dr. Laura Markham on April 24. The morning session had 70 Educators registered and the evening workshop was full with 190 registered participants.

4. Play Counts!- May 17

Program Coordinator Castaneda announced the upcoming workshop for parents and early childhood educators on May 17 to be presented by Denita Dinger, co-author of the book *Let Them Play: An Early Childhood Uncurriculum.* Participants will learn how to encourage young children to try new ideas, explore freely, collaborate, solve problems, handle conflicts, share and own discoveries. The fee to attend is \$15 for Irvine residents and \$20 for non-residents.

5. Junior Games- May 18

Supervisor Stubbler announced Junior Games, a fundraising track and field event in support of the Irvine Children's Fund, on May 18 at the Irvine High School Stadium from 9:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. Over 1,500 athletes, grades 4-8, will participate in the event.

6. New Irvine Child Care Project after school programs at Cypress Village and Portola Springs

Supervisor Stubbler announced Rainbow Rising was selected as the provider for both of the elementary schools. Cypress Village Rainbow Rising will open in September, and Portola Spring Rainbow Rising will open at its temporary site at Westwood for one year.
