1. Review of selected Super Saturday proposals

2. New Child Care Center opening

Milestones Montessori is expected to open by the end of November in the Irvine Business Complex area. The Center is expected to have a capacity of 270 infant/toddler through school-age children.

3. Week of the Young Child- April 12-18, 2015

The Week of the Young Child is sponsored by the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC). The week focuses public attention on the needs of young children and their families, and recognizes the early childhood programs and services that meet those needs.
