PRESENTATIONS

1. Understanding the Early Development Index- Sandy Avzaradel, Irvine Unified School District

The Irvine Unified School District, in partnership with the Children and Families Commission of Orange County, has begun using the Early Developmental Index (EDI). The EDI is a tool to evaluate the readiness of children when they enter kindergarten. Data is collected on each kindergarten student at each IUSD elementary school every three years. The EDI measures measures five key domain areas: 1) physical health and well-being, 2) social competence, 3) emotional maturity, 4) language and cognitive development, and 5) communication skills and general knowledge. The measurements are used to produce holistic, communitylevel measures of childhood development kindergarten year and identify the percentage of children who are vulnerable and on track by developmental domain. Ms. Avzaradel compared IUSD-specific data to the greater Orange County Kindergarten population. Committee Members were asked to consider the implications of this data for the City of Irvine and the impact of such numbers on programs and services.

The workshops address the emotional, social, intellectual and physical development of infants and toddlers and the supportive role of the caregiver. Topics include: building trust with infants and toddlers, understanding temperament of children and adults, and talking with parents about children's development.
