2. COUNTY OF ORANGE DEVELOPMENT PROPOSALS WITHIN THE CITY OF IRVINE

Barry Curtis, Manager of Planning Services, gave the presentation.

Discussion included how the County proposal might impact development at the Orange County Great Park, schools within Irvine and whether the City can comment on the County projects. The Commission also expressed concerns with development under County standards which are considered inferior to Irvine standards.

Chad Iverson, Menlo Equities, the applicant, was available to answer questions.

Chris Bevans, KiDA, addressed the issue of moving the gas meter for KiDA from the project site to the KiDA building.

Discussion included how much construction activity would occur and if this project was the highest and best use for this land.

Discussion included: 1) the size of the sign copy appeared to be large; 2) if the sign would be illuminated; and 3) if the sign could accommodate the words "City of Irvine" in smaller letters beneath the name of the project.

7. CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT FOR A UTILITY TOWER-MOUNTED (CLASS 6) WIRELESS COMMUNICATION FACILITY LOCATED ON AN EXISTING SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON ELECTRICAL TRANSMISSION TOWER ALONG THE WALNUT TRAIL, WEST OF YALE AVENUE AND NORTH OF SILVERWOOD IN PLANNING AREA 11 (EL CAMINO REAL)

Chair Kuo open the public hearing at 6:52 p.m.

Justin Equina, Associate Planner, gave the staff presentation.

Peter Blied, Plancom/Verizon, was available to answer questions.

Discussion included: 1) is the entire area under Edison easement; 2) questions about the microwave dish and the timing for its replacement with fiber optic lines; 3) the possibility of shortening the time for the approval of the microwave dish; 4) the ability of co-locations at this site; and, 4) who is responsible for property maintenance of the equipment shelter, particularly related to graffiti and vandalism.
