A regular meeting of the Green Ribbon Environmental Committee (Committee) was called to order on Thursday, February 12, 2015, at 4:42 p.m. at Sweet Shade Community Park, 15 Sweet Shade, by Administrator Reynolds.

INTRODUCTIONS

Committee Members and City staff introduced themselves. Committee Member Krom requested that Committee meetings be held at more central locations throughout the City to accommodate members that live in the northern areas of Irvine.

The selection of the Committee Chair and Vice-Chair was postponed until the next Committee meeting scheduled for May 14, 2015.

PRESENTATIONS

A. Brown Act Overview

Meredith Reynolds, Environmental Programs Administrator, presented an overview of the Ralph M. Brown Act. Committee Member Krom asked staff if the Act allowed the Committee to take the lead in organizing and conducting environmental outreach and awareness events, or conduct field trips to places of environmental interest. Administrator Reynolds responded that staff would research this issue. Committee Member Krom cautioned against over application of the Brown Act.

B. Jeffrey Open Space Trail

Meredith Reynolds, Environmental Programs Administrator, presented an overview of the Jeffrey Open Space Trail (JOST) project. Committee Member Smith requested more detail regarding the end of the trail near the I-5 Freeway, which Administrator Reynolds provided. Committee Member Krom requested a field trip tour of the trail be scheduled for the Committee, and that field trips to places of interest be scheduled in the future, perhaps as often as monthly. Administrator Reynolds stated that a tour of the JOST would be scheduled.

C. Environmental Programs Special Events: Paper Shredding and Used Oil Filter Exchange

Meredith Reynolds, Environmental Programs Administrator, presented an overview of the City's periodic paper shredding and Used Oil Filter Exchange community events. In response to Committee discussion, staff confirmed in addition to conducting special events, it assists Irvine residents in finding local shredding opportunities on an ongoing basis, informed the Committee that a full list of recyclable materials is included on the City's Environmental Programs website, and explained how waste diversion from landfills is measured. Committee Member Bhalla discussed the economic and environmental benefits of solar energy for homes and suggested greater use of social media to increase environmental awareness. Committee Member Krom suggested that sustainability success stories be added to the website as a regular feature, a database of new environmental ideas and action items be created by staff, and requested that an e-mail containing the "Healthy City, Healthy Planet" web link be sent to all GREC members.
