



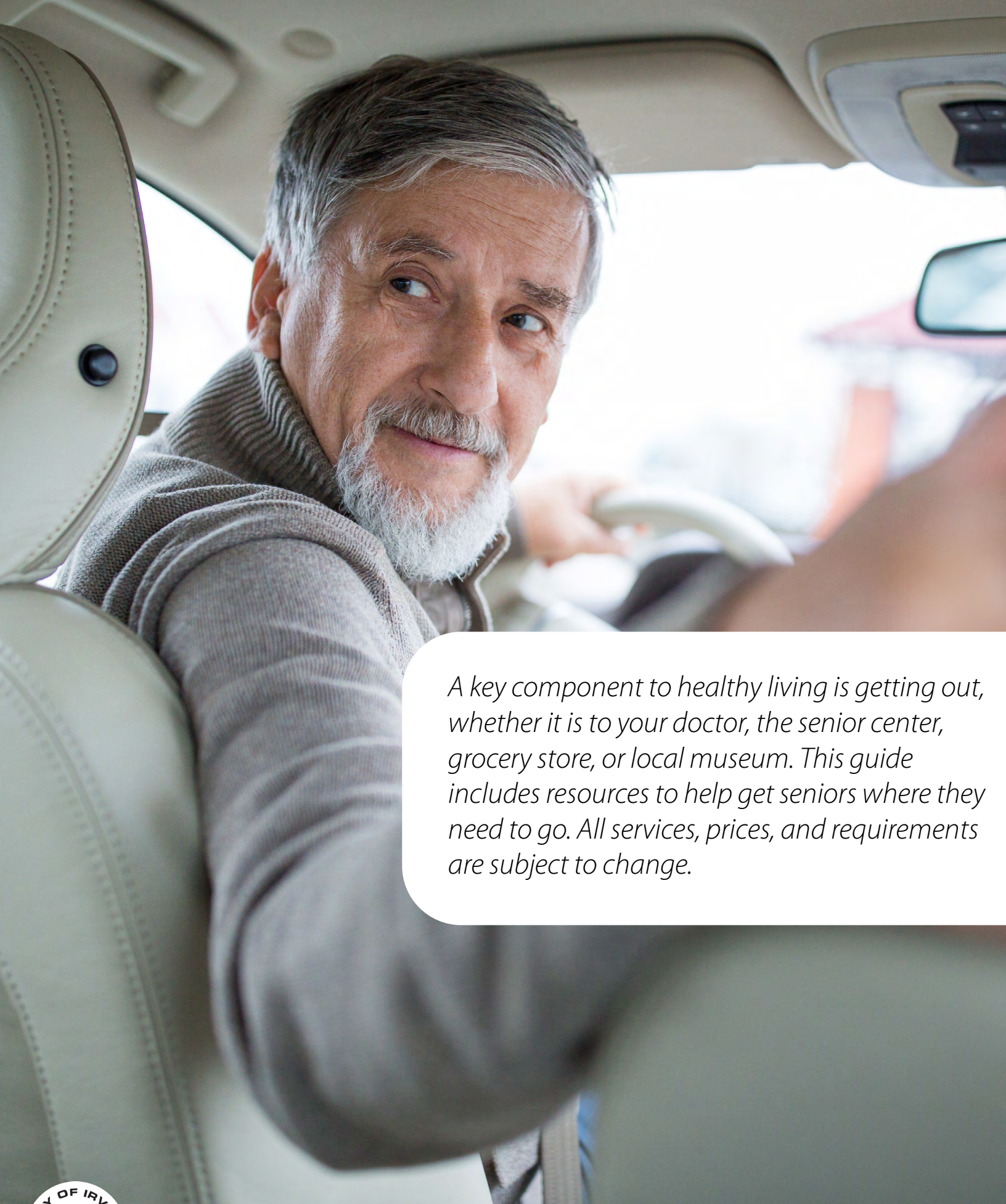

TRIPS

For Resident Seniors & Adults with Disabilities

The TRIPS program provides low-cost, wheelchair-accessible transportation to Irvine seniors and adults with disabilities. All participants must be unable to drive due to a physical or cognitive disability. TRIPS supports independent living and community involvement through safe, reliable and professional paratransit service. Pre-registration and program eligibility is required. For information and registration, call 949-724-7433.

- Curb-to-curb service.
- Lift equipped vehicles; wheelchair accessible.
- Service area is limited to the City of Irvine and adjacent cities.
- Shuttle service to Lakeview and Rancho senior centers as well as Trabuco Center.
- Grocery shopping at various Irvine markets.
- Rides are on first-come-first-served basis and must be scheduled in advance.

FARE INFORMATION

- \$25 registration fee for initial enrollment.
- \$20 annual renewal fee.
- Ride tickets are purchased for \$30 and used for ride payment. Tickets must be purchased prior to making ride requests.
- \$1.90 one-way to any location in Irvine.
- Transportation to adjacent cities is limited and costs range from \$3.80 to 5.70 per one-way ride.

SERVICE HOURS

- Monday–Friday, 8 a.m.–5 p.m.
- The TRIPS program is closed on all City-observed holidays.

RESERVATION HOURS

- Monday–Friday, 8 a.m.–5 p.m.

Senior Center Express

Catch a ride to the Irvine Senior Centers. All Irvine residents 65 years of age and older, regardless of driver's license status, can register to request rides from their home to the Lakeview and Rancho senior centers or Trabuco Center. Rides are available at predetermined Senior Center Express times. Call 949-724-7433 for registration process and details.

OC ACCESS

For Residents with Disabilities

- OC ACCESS is for people unable to use regular, fixed-route bus service due to functional limitations caused by a disability.
- Passengers meet American with Disabilities (ADA) eligibility criteria and must be certified by OC ACCESS testing.

SCHEDULING A RIDE

- Certified individuals can schedule an OC ACCESS ride from one to three days in advance, or schedule a same-day ride by calling 877-628-2232.
- For TDD, call 800-564-4232.

FARE INFORMATION

- One-way, standard curb-to-curb service: \$3.60 each way.
- Escorted premium service to/from door: \$5 additional charge each segment customer is escorted.
- Companion fare for a person to accompany an ACCESS passenger: \$3.60.
- Same-Day Taxi Service: You pay the OC ACCESS base fare of \$3.60 for a five-mile ride and OCTA will subsidize the rest of the trip. Any additional costs incurred by traveling beyond the five-mile trip are to be paid by the ACCESS customer.

For Residents & Employees

The iShuttle is a fixed-route commuter shuttle system, which transports Irvine residents and employees to and from their home and/or workplace.

- Easy, convenient, efficient, and safe travel.
- Connects with Metrolink and Amtrak trains, as well as Orange County Transit Authority (OCTA) buses.
- Wheelchair accessible; accommodates two wheelchairs.

FARE INFORMATION

- Free with valid Metrolink or OCTA pass, or purchase a 10-ride card on-board for \$5.
- \$1 boarding during peak hours.

SERVICE HOURS

- Operates Monday–Friday, approximately 6–9 a.m. and 3–6:30 p.m.

Route A: Connects Tustin Metrolink Station and John Wayne Airport along Von Karman Avenue.

Route B: Connects Tustin Metrolink Station and John Wayne Airport along Jamboree Road and Michelson Drive.

Route C: Connects Irvine Station (Metrolink and Amtrak trains) to Alton Parkway, Irvine Center Drive, and Sand Canyon (ends at Capital Group).

Route D: Connects Irvine Station (Metrolink and Amtrak trains) to Barranca Parkway, Irvine Spectrum Center, Pacifica/Meridian, Alton Parkway, and Sand Canyon (ends at Kaiser and Hoag Hospitals).

Nationwide Intercity Rail System with Several Stops Throughout Orange County & Southern California

Amtrak provides daily trips to and from Los Angeles, Santa Barbara, and San Diego with stops in the following Orange County cities: Anaheim, Fullerton, Irvine, San Clemente, San Juan Capistrano, and Santa Ana.

- Easy, convenient, reliable, and safe travel.
- Most trains are wheelchair accessible and wheelchair assistance can be provided when trains do not have accessibility.

FARE INFORMATION

- Fares are calculated by distance.
- Discounts for seniors, students, military (active duty and retired).
- Tickets may be purchased online, by phone, at a station ticket machine, or Amtrak counter (Irvine Station has an Amtrak counter).

DIRECTIONS

- **From I-5 Freeway:** exit at Alton Parkway (Near Ada St.), go east on Alton to Ada, then north on Ada.
- **From I-405 freeway:** exit Irvine Center Drive, go north on Irvine Center Drive to Alton, then east on Alton, and north on Barranca.

PARKING

- Complimentary 1,650 parking spaces are available in the parking structure (72 hours overnight parking only).

AMENITIES

- Restrooms, waiting room, ATM machine, food services, bike lockers, vending machines, information kiosks, and ticket machines.

- **From I-5 Freeway:** exit Jamboree Rd., go west onto Jamboree Rd. to Edinger Ave., then north on Edinger to the first traffic signal, and turn right into Tustin Station.
- **From I-405 Freeway:** exit Jamboree Rd., go west onto Jamboree Rd. to Edinger Ave., then north on Edinger to the first traffic signal, turn right into the Tustin Station.

- Approximately 932 parking spaces.

Non-Emergency Medical Transportation

For Non-emergency Medical Appointments throughout South Orange County

- This program provides transportation to medical appointments including therapy, dentistry, hearing, dialysis, prescription pick-ups, testing and x-rays. Also, transportation to Kaiser Anaheim, Long Beach Veteran's Hospital, UCI Medical Center (Orange) and St. Joseph Hospital of Orange.
- Participants must be at least 60 years of age.
- Must reside within Orange County's designated service area: Aliso Viejo, Dana Point, Irvine, Laguna Beach, Laguna Hills, Laguna Niguel, Laguna Woods, Lake Forest, Mission Viejo, Newport Beach, Rancho Santa Margarita, San Clemente, and San Juan Capistrano.
- Clients are limited to a maximum of 16 one-way trips per month (or eight round trips).

FARE INFORMATION

- \$2 per one-way trip; exact change (attendant rides free).

SERVICE HOURS

- Monday–Friday, 7 a.m.–6 p.m.
- Transportation not available on major holidays

SCHEDULING A RIDE

- Rides must be scheduled at least five business days in advance and will be subject to availability.

For Non-emergency Medical Appointments

Irvine Senior Service Outreach program coordinates with volunteers to provide free transportation for seniors to medical appointments.

- Transportation for residents ages 50 and older who are unable to drive.
- Volunteer drivers.
- Cannot accommodate wheelchairs.
- Limited to two trips per month.

CarFit

CarFit is an education program developed by the Automobile Association of America (AAA), AARP, and the American Occupational Therapy Association.

- Offers adults the opportunity to check how well their personal vehicle “fits” them.
- A trained volunteer technician will lead drivers through a 15-minute, 12-point vehicle checklist, recommending vehicle adjustments and adaptations for safer fit.
