#### STAFF PRESENTATION

Mark Asturias advised that State of California recently released a Notice of Available Funding for a program that will facilitate transit-oriented development that can include provisions to serve persons with special needs. Guidelines for the program are currently being refined.

Mark Asturias responded to questions about the status of the Settlement Agreement among the City of Irvine, the Successor Agency to the Dissolved Irvine Redevelopment Agency, the Irvine Community Land Trust, and the California Department of Finance. He stated that the California State Superior Court is slated to hear the matter on October 24. If upheld by the State Superior Court proceeds will be received by both the City of Irvine and the Irvine Community Land Trust. The schedule of proceeds to the Irvine Community Land Trust will be based upon property tax increment over the next 12 years.
