1. Public Facilities Reservation and Fee Policy Proposed Changes and Impacts

Superintendent Sheila Driscoll shared that to enhance safety of all aquatics facility patrons, the City's new supervision standards for William Woollett Jr. and Northwood Aquatics Centers require all water activities to be supervised by City lifeguards. Although the City will begin its transition of lifeguarding activities immediately, charges for lifeguards will not be passed on to the group users until the Public Facilities Reservation and Fee Policy is approved by City Council. The Policy changes related to Aquatics

services will include expanded lifeguard service requirements, a \$17 per hour fee for lifeguard services and removing City requirements for coaching certifications. Superintendent Driscoll and Supervisor Moodie will meet with the Aquatics group users to discuss impacts of this new standard of supervision requirement.
