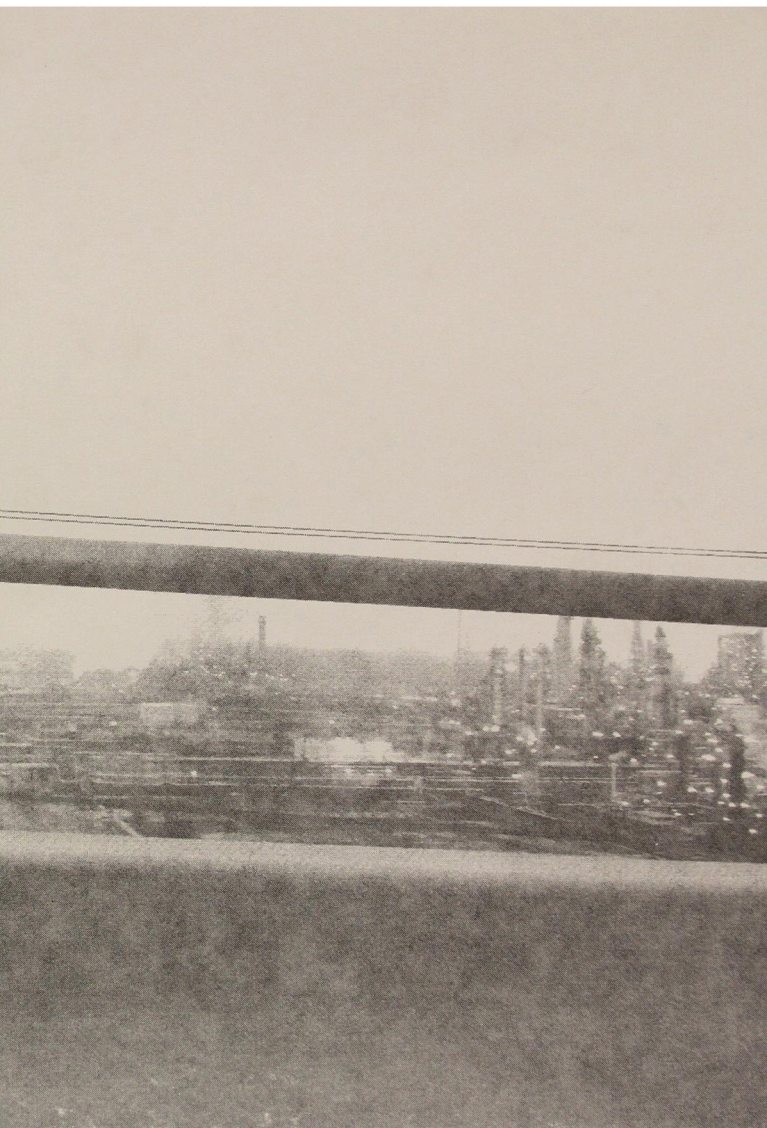

Lindsay Buchman's solo exhibition *Y(OURS)* explores the relationship between personal and collective property and what it means to own through works on paper, sculpture, a site-specific installation and a risograph publication.

Lindsay Buchman is an interdisciplinary artist working between Philadelphia and Southern California. Her practice explores instability and disintegration; memory; and the dissonance between language and communication. Buchman engages the viewer through text, image and structure. Recent projects examine the role of the archive, public memory and private history.

Buchman has exhibited at Robert Blackburn Gallery, NY; SHO Gallery, NY; The Danforth Museum of Art, MA; Art Share-LA, CA; LA Artcore Brewery Annex, CA; The Torrance Art Museum, CA; Keystone Gallery, CA and Temple University, Italy. She holds a BFA in Printmaking from the School of Art, California State University Long Beach, and is an MFA candidate at the University of Pennsylvania.
