Committee Members Daroy, Im and Jeliazkova provided a presentation on the High School Youth Action Team and its presence on high school campuses.

Discussion included: membership numbers; recruitment process; meeting frequency; types of events conducted.

1. Irvine Children's Health Program Update

Senior Management Analyst Gruschka announced the Coalition of Orange County Community Health Centers is the new Irvine Children's Health Program operator and began providing health insurance enrollment services on October 6, 2015 at the Youth Employment Office at Heritage Park.

2. Tax-preparation/Earned Income Tax Credit Program

Senior Management Analyst Gruschka announced the tax assistance program will be offered at designated community locations, including Cypress Community Park,

DISCUSSION

Future Community Forum Topics

The following topics were suggested and discussed by the committee for future forums:

- Technology: Benefiting from personal technology while avoiding the negative effects such as cyber bullying, overuse, and decline in interpersonal relationships; Age-appropriate use of technology; and parental monitoring (Votes = 6)
- 2. Safety: Ideas about keeping children safe at all ages including household safety and other topics. (Votes = 1)
- 3. Culture of Perfection: In this competitive environment, where ambition and achievement are valued, do we sometimes go too far? Do children need more play and less pressure? How do we find the balance that is best for our children at every age? Presentation may include discussion of growth and development, early academics and competitive sports. (Votes = 6)
- 4. Healthy Failure: Learning to lose, concept of grit, fear of failure, fear of trying new things. (Votes = 10)
- 5. Parental Technology Controls and Awareness: Using Cyberwise as a resource. (Votes = 5)
- 6. Peer Competition versus Healthy Competition: (Votes = 0)
- 7. Mental Health First Aid: How to help peers/children when concerned they may be showing signs of mental health issues. (Votes = 3)
- 8. Repairing the World/Environmental Friendliness: (Votes = 1)

- 9. Finding Balance: Finding one's passion separate from academics. (Votes = 2)
- 10. Basic Life Skills: Financial responsibility, money management, acquiring skills such as changing tires, cooking, etc. (Votes = 7)
- 11. Conflict Resolution: Developing skills including ability to compromise, and resolving internal and external conflicts. (Votes = 2)

Topics will be evaluated based on votes, with the highest ranking used to develop future community education forums. The next forum is tentatively planned for spring 2016.
