## **PRESENTATIONS**

Child Care Needs Assessment – Traci Stubbler, Child Care Coordination Supervisor

Supervisor Stubbler provided a presentation on the City of Irvine Child Care Needs Assessment, an analysis of existing supply and demand for child care, and future demand through City build-out, expected by 2035. Committee discussion included: history of the needs assessment project; definition of child care; needs assessment methodology; and siting of new child care centers in shopping centers.

### **1. Community Education Forum – Screen Time and Youth**

Senior Management Analyst Laurie Gruschka announced the forum on screen time/technology and youth will be held on October 13. The event includes a screening of the documentary film *Screenagers* followed by a question and answer session with a panel of experts.
