
**BOARD DISCUSSION**


ABLE Act – Board Member Harvey provided information on the ABLE Act, Uber transportation, and a locating application called “tile”.


Discussion included: ABLE act account letters being sent by the State of California; Uber transportation as a reliable source for individuals with disabilities to travel.
