INTRODUCTIONS

PRESENTATIONS

City of Irvine Strategic Plan for Children, Youth and Families – Laurie Gruschka Community Services Senior Management Analyst.

Comprised of 12 strategies under six goal areas, the City of Irvine Strategic Plan for Children, Youth and Families, represents the City's vision to create and maintain a safe community where children, youth and families thrive emotionally, physically, academically and socially. Laurie Gruschka highlighted Goal Area two on Child Care and School Readiness and shared key achievements that have been made in the first five years of the plan. The Strategic Plan for Children, Youth and Families Update for 2013-18 is a continuation of the Strategic Plan 2008-13, and will guide the City for the next five years. It builds directly on the previous plan and is the result of community input, City staff recommendations and feedback from the Irvine Children, Youth and Families Advisory Committee.

1. Welcome to Kindergarten

Community Services Program Coordinator Diana Castaneda confirmed the dates for the two events; January 19 for Tustin Unified School District and February 9 for Irvine Unified School District (IUSD). Event fliers have been distributed to early childhood programs. IUSD information will be available online for those unable to attend.

2. Request for Super Saturday Volunteers

Program Coordinator Castaneda announced two events are confirmed: March 11 for school age providers; May 6 for early childhood providers. Both will be held from 8:30 a.m. to 2 p.m. at the Lakeview Senior Center. Committee Members were invited to volunteer on March 11.

3. Recap of Irvine Child Care Project (ICCP) Director's Forum

Community Services Supervisor Traci Stubbler announced ICCP hosted "The Upset Parent" forum, presented by Meike Lemmens. Attendees (40 ICCP providers) learned techniques and strategies on how to have an effective parent conference when discussing difficult or sensitive topics.

4. Upcoming Family Child Care Provider Workshop

Program Coordinator Castaneda announced the University of California, Davis Center for Excellence in Family Day Care Homes will provide a 5-hour workshop to family child care providers and private preschool programs on "Caring for Mixed Age Children".

5. ICCP Child Care Provider Selection for Culverdale and Eastwood Village Elementary Schools

Supervisor Stubbler announced Koala Club (current ICCP before and after school child care provider on the Culverdale Elementary school campus) will cease operations on June 9, after 24 years of service to the school. ICCP is currently accepting applications to select a new provider at Culverdale. ICCP will also be conducting a provider selection process to operate the program at the new Eastwood Village Elementary school to open in August 2017.

6. City of Irvine Child Care Map

Program Coordinator Castaneda shared a draft of the updated aerial map of child care center locations within the City of Irvine. Once finalized, the map will be added to the Child Care Coordination website to assist families in locating child care centers.

7. Orange County Child Care Zoning Regulations Research

Supervisor Stubbler reported that the City's Community Development Department is working with their interns to collect data on Child Care zoning regulations from other Orange County Cities.
