



The City of Irvine Invites Your Comments on Environmental Issues

A Notice of Preparation (NOP) pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the City of Irvine CEQA Guidelines was released for a 30-day comment period that began on April 20, 2017. The purpose of the NOP is to solicit input from individuals, organizations and public agencies on environmental issues that should be addressed in the Environmental Impact Report (EIR) being prepared for the PAs 12/40 General Plan Amendment and Zone Change Project.
