The *High School Art Exhibition* is a multimedia show featuring art produced by students from Irvine high schools, including drawing, painting, printmaking, photography, digital media, ceramics and sculpture.

High School Art Exhibition juror **Rachelle W. Chuang** lives a creative life as an artist, designer, educator, curator and tutor. She earned her Bachelor of Arts in Graphic Design from Biola University and her Master of Fine Arts from University of the Arts in Philadelphia. She has taught in the art and graphic design departments at seven colleges in Southern California over the past nine years as both a full-time and adjunct professor, and is currently teaching at Chapman University, Biola University and Irvine Valley College. Her handmade paper sculptures, letterpress prints and collages have been exhibited in numerous group shows and published in several books. She has also taught classes at the Irvine Fine Arts Center and has contributed to its Printmaking program. Rachelle will be exhibiting her work at the Festival of the Arts in Laguna Beach this summer.
