2. JEFFREY OPEN SPACE TRAIL I-5 BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE

Cheryl Lea, Associate Transportation Analyst, presented the item and answered questions. Gary Warkentin, Project Manager, Michael Baker International, was also available for questions.

Commission discussion included: 1) identifying the preferred setback and alignment with the road; 2) meeting with various stakeholders and the Planning Commission regarding land use; 3) the environmental process and right-of-way impacts; 4) accessibility and connectivity; 5) the evolution on setback requirements with regard to safety; 6) identifying primary stakeholders: Southern California Edison and Manassero Farms; 7) project funding, grant applications, timeline and working with Caltrans; 8) recommending that the City have an opportunity to provide input in the aesthetics of the bridge; 9) Manassero Farms termination of current lease and reinstatement of new lease agreement.

ACTION: Moved by Vice-Chair Greenberg, seconded by Commissioner Casey, motion carried 5-0 to:

Recommend that the City Council approve the Cooperative Agreement with OCTA for grant funding and proceed with the Final Design and Rightof-Way phase. The Commission also recommends that the Council undertake an aesthetic study as part of the bridge design process. 3.
