#### INTRODUCTIONS

#### PRESENTATIONS

1. Distinguished Service Award

Community Services Supervisor Ed Kaleikini described the corner banner display project completed by Asher Lee, Eagle Scout from Troop 856 and announced the award will be presented to him at a separate event.

2. Emergency Evacuation Process and Fire Extinguisher Demonstration

Supervisor Kaleikini provided a presentation on safe evacuation procedures for the senior centers and proper use of fire extinguishers. Handouts were provided.

3. Strategic Plan Connectivity

Supervisor Conger provided a presentation on connectivity between the County of Orange Office on Aging, Orange County Strategic Plan for Aging and City of Irvine Senior Services efforts toward strategic planning. A handout was provided.

Discussion included: budget for the implementation of Senior Services Strategic Plan (SSSP) Update initiatives; importance of collaborations across all governmental levels; traffic counts to Senior Services website; and homelessness among seniors.

#### COMMITTEE/GROUP/AGENCY REPORTS

#### 1. Senior Services Support/Interest Groups

A. Irvine Adult Day Health Services (IADHS)

Chair Inmon shared information about her family's experience using IADHS.

B. Irvine Evergreen Chinese Senior Association (IECSA)

Director Jerry Chang thanked attendees of the Chinese New Year event. Director Chang reported the March 17 meeting will include: a lecture on memory loss; musical performances; entertainment; a class in Chinese painting; sharing of current events; instruction on basic English.

Discussion included: recent episodes of seniors wandering away from home; technology to locate lost seniors.

C. Friends of Outreach (FOO)

President Pat Hendee reported the Bingo program has been averaging \$500 per week in funds raised since the beginning of the year, participation is up to an average of 70 participants, and volunteers are needed to assist in the program. The International Crafters have begun working on knitting scarves for the 2018 Holiday Gift Bag project and made 1,245 chemo caps in 2017. The Ruby's Diner fundraiser raised \$62, and future fundraisers have been planned for Chili's on Alton and at Rodrigo's in Tustin. The FOO business license was renewed in February.

- E. NEDA-Association of Iranian American Seniors (NEDA)

President Nasser Fathi reported the actual date for Nowruz (the Persian New Year) is March 20, however NEDA will celebrate the holiday on March 15 at 6 p.m. The weekly meetings on Thursdays from 2-6 p.m. have seen an increase in participation, and NEDA is now discussing options for providing daily programs.

F. Irvine Korean Evergreen Association (IKEA)

President Juneu Kim reported all IKEA classes are going well and he, as President, is working to instill the spirit of community service among IKEA's members. Appointments are available for referrals and resources on Tuesdays from 8-9 a.m. and Wednesdays 4:30 p.m. at the Lakeview Senior Center. IKEA is providing an internship experience for high school students, with a current task of reviewing SSSP resource information for currency and accuracy.
