

Lesley Kice Nishigawara: REPEAT

Orange County-based artist Lesley Kice Nishigawara's work explores grids, patterns, structures and networks that she observes in the built environment, from emerging buildings on the side of the freeway to retaining walls in the mountains of Japan. Through a series of image manipulations and algorithms created by the artist, these visuals are translated in her intricately constructed paper and textile works, weavings, drawings, photographs and sculptures.
