This exhibition offers a look at the shifting dynamics of family relationships undergoing change. Three artists explore how established, seemingly permanent roles within families are adjusted as a result of birth, growth, aging, and loss. Parenthood becomes part of artistic practice; a shift in responsibility reveals newfound personal strength; the energy at the center of a family quietly fades. These narratives are explored through photography, video, and installation in the three distinct practices of Ching Ching Cheng, Juliana Rico, and Jane Szabo, all in search of new equilibrium within their family structures.
