- Reduce unused allocations (savings & improve availability)
- Commitment to highest quality in the region & best value

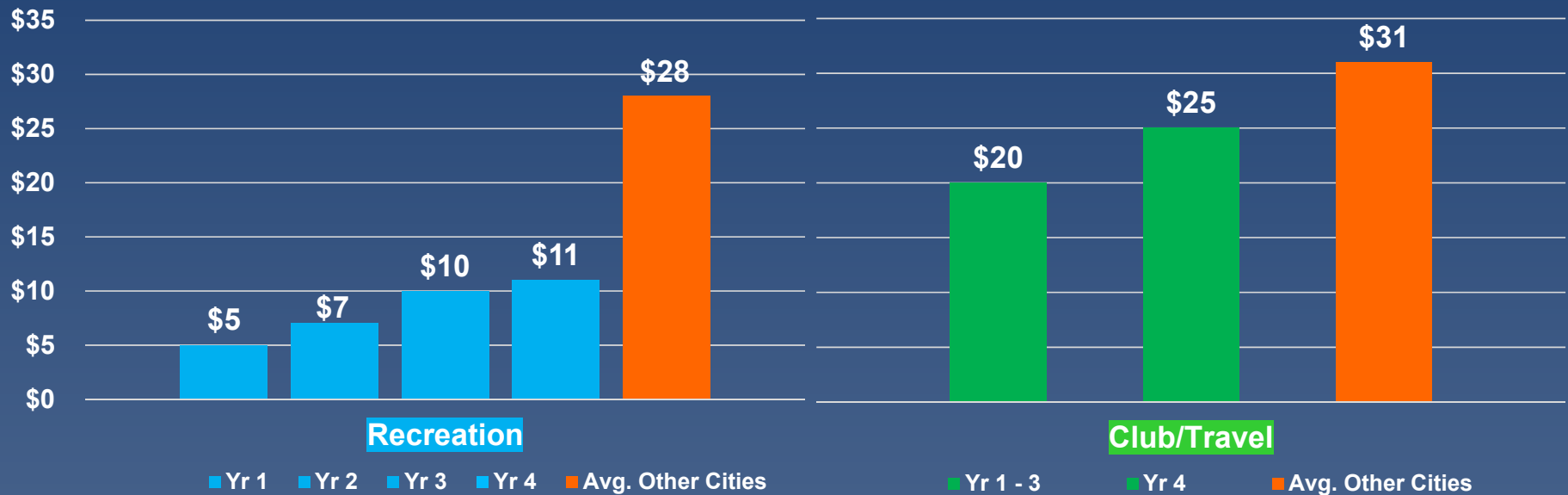

- Reduced maintenance in secondary season
 - Level 1 professional contractor morning preps reduced
 - Level 2 (City staff) intra-day preps continue

Season	Current Level 1	Revised Level 1
Primary	5x per week	No change
Secondary	5x per week	2x per week (Mon & Fri)

- 4 year cost reduction of \$760,000 on \$800,000 gap
 - \$190,000 annually; consistent approach maintains quality
- No changes: mowing, fertilizing, sod replacement, aeration
