1. FEDERATION WAY SCHOOL AREA UPDATE

1) Recommend that City Council adopt - A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IRVINE, CALIFORNIA, WHICH CERTIFIES THAT THE CITY OF IRVINE HAS THE RESOURCES TO FUND THE PROJECTS IN THE FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2020-21 THROUGH 2025-26 FEDERAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AND AFFIRMS ITS COMMITMENT TO IMPLEMENT ALL PROJECTS IN THE PROGRAM.
