## Foil Stained Glass



### *Supplies needed:*

- **Cardboard sheet**  
Any cardboard will work: cereal boxes, old amazon boxes, discarded packaging, etc.
- **Aluminum foil**
- **Colored Sharpies/ Markers**
- **Ball-point pen**
- **Hot glue gun (adults only!)**  
Optional: Elmer's Glue/Tacky Glue
- **Masking tape**

## Step 1



- Use the pencil to draw on the cardboard sheet. Draw whatever you like!
- Note that the more detailed the drawing, the harder Step 2 will be.

## Step 2



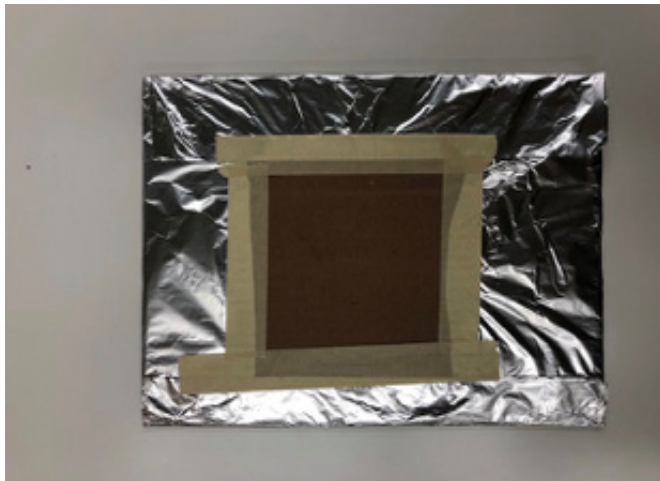
- Have an ADULT use the hot glue gun to go over the lines of the drawing.
- Tip: Holding the tip of the hot glue gun closer to the cardboard will create thicker lines, holding it farther away will create thinner lines.
- *Optional: Use Elmer's glue or Tacky glue instead of hot glue. This will require extra time to dry.*

## Step 3



- Once the glue has dried, place the cardboard sheet, glue side down, on a piece of foil.
- Fold the extra foil over the backside of the cardboard, keep the foil as tight as possible.
- Adhere the foil to the cardboard using masking tape.

## Step 4



- Flip the foil wrapped sheet of cardboard over.
- Use your index finger to smooth out the foil and reveal the dried glue underneath.

## Step 5



- Use the Colored Sharpies/Markers to color in your foil like a coloring sheet.
- Make sure to stay in the lines created by the glue underneath the foil.
- Tip: Don't press too hard while coloring to avoid puncturing the foil.
