Paper Flowers

Learn how to create paper flowers using printed photographs in this photo-based video tutorial. Craft a bouquet of memories with items you likely have at home.



MATERIALS NEEDED:

- Photos printed on basic white computer paper, printed photos on photo paper, or images clipped from a magazine or newspaper
- Round object for tracing a circle (*a roll of masking tape or the bottom of a mug/ water glass are a good size*)
- Pen
- Scissors
- Glue (*glue stick, white glue, or hot glue gun*)
- Floral wire, pipe cleaners, or large paper clips
- Floral tape or ribbon
- 1 thumb tack
- Small piece of cardboard
- **Optional:** *markers, colored pencils, watercolors*
