# Magnets

Learn how to create a set of fun customized glass marble magnets using photos.



## MATERIALS NEEDED:

- Photos you don't mind cutting up or copies of the photos, newspaper or magazine clippings, colorful paper, or tiny collages
- Mod Podge (*glossy or matte*); Elmer's white glue can be used if Mod Podge is not available
- Glue that works on glass and metal (*Weldbond is instructor's preferred option*)
- Clear glass **FLAT BACK** marbles (*they are sometimes labeled as "decorative filler"*) or glass cabochons (*25mm work well*). The cabochons are perfect circles and the marbles have a more organic edge. Both will work for this project.
- 3/4" circular magnets
- Pen
- Scissors
- Quarter for tracing
- Optional: *Mint tin*
