2026 SPRING ADULT SOCCER REGISTRATION

The Community Services Department is now accepting applications for its Adult Soccer Program, Spring 2026 season. Men's, Women's, and Coed 7 vs 7 and Men's 11 vs 11 are now being formed. The season tentatively runs from February 2 through April 9 for all leagues. All leagues will be scheduled a total of 9 guaranteed games. (8 regular season, 1 playoff). Should a team advance past the first round of playoffs, they will play in the championship game (10th total game).

Irvine soccer leagues are governed by FIFA rules, except where City of Irvine rules modify or supersede those rules, as outlined in the league bylaws.

NOTE: The City of Irvine will **NOT** assume responsibility for injury: **EVERYONE PARTICIPATES AT THEIR OWN RISK.** SCMAF offers seasonal team insurance or insurance that will cover your team for the calendar year. Please visit scmaf.org/insurance for information and costs of these two insurance options.

1. PROCEDURE TO ENTER A TEAM

A. The **deadline** for registering on yourrvine.org, paying the league fees, and submitting a team roster and questionnaire is:

Sunday, January 25, 2026, at 10:00pm for ALL leagues.

B. Please make check payable to "City of Irvine". **NOTE: Only one personal check per team.**
(Have players make checks out to one person and have that person write the check for the team fees).
Please write team name and check writer's driver's license number on front of the personal check.

- C. Rosters must be submitted on an official City of Irvine Spring 2026 soccer roster.
- D. All entries received after the deadline or in excess of the nightly maximum will be placed if spots are available.
- E. Teams that do not qualify for placement in the league will be notified and issued a full refund.
- F. Any team that wishes to withdraw after having submitted their roster and fee will be subject to the following penalty schedule:

<u>Team Announces Withdrawal</u>	<u>Penalty</u>
On or before registration deadline	None
Registration deadline up until teams' league has been scheduled	\$200
After teams have been scheduled	Full \$725/\$1,595

2. ELIGIBILITY

- A. Players must be at least eighteen (18) years of age on or before the first league game.
- B. Players **MUST** have a City of Irvine Soccer ID card at the game site in order to be eligible to participate in games. ID Cards can be obtained at the Adult Sports office for a one-time cost of \$15.
- C. A maximum of two women may be rostered on a "Men's" team. Men are not permitted on "Women's" league rosters.
- D. Players may not play on more than one team in the same league.

3. TIMETABLE

Team registration: **January 3 – January 25, 2026**

Tentative Season: **Week of February 2 – Week of April 9, 2026**

4. ROSTERS

- A. Each team shall submit an official, complete roster of not more than sixteen (16) players for all 7 vs 7 leagues and twenty-two (22) for all 11 vs 11 leagues. Players must sign the roster **AT THE PARK OFFICE WITH A PICTURE ID** before playing. This will be done at the first game that each player plays during a given season.
- B. ROSTER ADDITIONS (no deletions are permitted) may be made up until the start of your sixth (6) league game for 7 vs. 7 leagues, and up until the start of your 4th (4) league game for 11 vs. 11 leagues. No roster changes may be made after these deadlines for ALL leagues without sufficient proof of necessity and approval from the league office. All roster additions must be made at the park office where the team is scheduled to play and placed directly onto the roster filed at the park office. Additions cannot be made after the deadline listed.
- C. All players **MUST** have a Player ID Card in order to be eligible to play.
