

CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 22-64

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IRVINE, CALIFORNIA, REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF ORANGE TO CONSOLIDATE A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 8, 2022, WITH THE STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE SAME DATE PURSUANT TO § 10403 OF THE ELECTIONS CODE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Irvine, California, called a General Municipal Election to be held on November 8, 2022, for the purpose of the election of a Mayor, and two Members of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the General Municipal Election be consolidated with the Statewide General Election to be held on the same date and that within the city the precincts, polling places/vote centers, and election officers of the two elections be the same, and that the Orange County Registrar of Voters canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election and that the Election be held in all respects as if there were only one election.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IRVINE, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to the requirements of § 10403 of the Elections Code, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Orange is hereby requested to consent and agree to the consolidation of a General Municipal Election with the Statewide General Election on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, for the purpose of the election of a Mayor, and two Members of the City Council.

SECTION 2. That pursuant to City Charter, Article IV, Section 400, if at any general municipal election should a Council Member whose term of office will not expire as of the election files as a candidate for the office of Mayor, the voters will be instructed on the ballot that they may cast ballots for not more than three (3) candidates for the office of Council Member. In the event a Council Member whose term of office will not expire is elected to the office of Mayor, the candidate receiving the third highest number of votes will fill the vacancy created by the Council Member who was elected to the office of Mayor.

SECTION 3. That the Orange County Registrar of Voters is authorized to canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election. The Election shall be held in all respects as if there were only one election, and only one form of ballot shall be used. The election will be held and conducted in accordance with the provisions of law regulating the statewide election.

SECTION 4. That the Board of Supervisors is requested to issue instructions to the Orange County Registrar of Voters to take any and all steps necessary for the holding of the consolidated election.

SECTION 5. That the City of Irvine recognizes that additional costs will be incurred by the County of Orange by reason of this consolidation and agrees to reimburse the County of Orange for any costs.

SECTION 6. That the City Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Board of Supervisors and the Orange County Registrar of Voters of the County of Orange.

SECTION 7. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
