

## What is a CAAP?










Estimates existing and future greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions.

Sets GHG reduction targets.

Recommends policies and actions to meet reduction targets.

Integrates climate adaptation and resilience strategies.



Engages the community.



Provides an implementation plan.

What does climate adaptation mean?


Climate Action is taking steps to reduce the causes of climate change, such as GHG emissions, and reducing potential future impacts.

Climate Adaptation is preparing for the impacts of climate change and reducing the negative effects of these impacts.
