Question	Answer
Can you define how a mental health service would be duplicative of BeWell?	A mental health service would be duplicative of BeWell if the proposed service was the same service for the same population (a service that is already available in Irvine). Would a non-profit operated by volunteers with no employee eligible for the vulnerable population grant?	Yes.

Our agency has a Employer Federal ID. Do we need to apply for a UEI or DUNS# too?	No.
Some of our services are eligible for partial coverage by some health insurance policies. Can we require that participants leverage to check into their health insurance coverage?	Yes, you can require that participants check their health insurance coverage.
Can we make the services provided available to non-Irvine residents? If so, do we need to charge non-Irvine residents as opposed to Irvine residents?	The IRP grant funds can only be used to cover Irvine residents. You can provide the services to non-Irvine residents, as long as you are not using the IRP funds to cover those costs.
Can services such as need-based scholarships be provided? Or do all service costs need to be covered for Irvine residents?	You can provide need-based scholarships. There may be documentation required to show how need was determined.
Can we provide a copy of last year's profit and loss statements, rather than an audited financial statement?	The application requires submission of either a recent audited financial statement or a current balance sheet and profit/loss income statement.
