1.1 STRATEGIC PLAN FOR CHILDREN, YOUTH AND FAMILIES: STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT PLAN

Christina Altmayer from Health Management Associates (HMA) provided an overview and update to ICYFAC regarding the Strategic Plan for Children, Youth and Families. The presentation included the following:

- Project Goal: Produce an updated five-year Strategic Plan for Children, Youth and Families in Irvine
- Stakeholder engagement update included a summary of efforts to gather qualitative input regarding the needs of children, youth, and families through focus groups, town halls, meetings, and interviews. The Summary of survey responses as of May 17, 2023 was also discussed.
- HMA will facilitate meeting with Core Group (June-August) to (1) elicit feedback and ideas emerging from the data and (2) develop recommendations related to plan goals and strategies.
- Work through a process in late summer/early fall to vet recommendations with key stakeholders (e.g., City leadership, Irvine Unified School District (IUSD) leadership, ICYFAC).
- Develop initial strategic plan framework.

HSYAT completed over 20,000 hours of service in the past school year, supporting over 650 volunteer opportunities for local nonprofits and City programs and events, with 1,016 high school volunteers. HSYAT hosted three sessions of volunteer camps with 73 participants completed over 700 hours of service during the spring break. During the summer, HSYAT will host 16 week-long sessions of Summer Teen Volunteer Camps serving over 300 students and will be offering college tour throughout the summer.
