## SPECIAL EVENT COORDINATOR ACCESSIBILITY INDEMNIFICATION

As Special Event Coordinator, I take responsibility and liability to provide requirements for accessibility to the site, facilities, and elements by individuals with disabilities, related to the special event in accordance with the 2022 California Building Code (CBC). The requirements are, but not limited to, the following:

**STAGE ACCESSIBILITY:** Stages and platforms require accessibility in the form of either a wheelchair lift or ramp. Ramps shall have a maximum 1 inch rise to 12 inch run slope, be 48 inches wide, have wheel guards, have 42 inch high minimum guardrails, and have handrails mounted between 34 inches and 38 inches above the ramp surface.

Top Landing:  $60'' \times 60''$ 

Change of Direction Landing: 72" in direction heading down x 60"

Mid-Run Landing: 60" in direction heading down x ramp width 72" in direction heading down x ramp width

**ACCESSIBLE ROUTES:** Accessible routes from accessible parking or drop off zones to facility entrance and/or access routes to all amenities shall not exceed slopes of 5% in the direction of travel and 2% cross slope.

**RESTROOM FACILITIES:** Where both accessible and non-accessible restroom facilities serving the venue are not within 200 feet, provide portable restrooms; 5% of portable restroom facilities provided shall be accessible.

**ACCESSIBLE PARKING:** Keep existing accessible parking available. Otherwise, relocated accessible parking stall shall have loading aisles configured in a manner the person using the accessible parking space does not go behind another vehicle besides their own. The loading aisle shall be on an accessible path to venue with the circulation path no greater than a 5% slope and cross slope no greater than 2%. Where additional parking is provided for the event, accessible parking shall be made available in quantities per 2022 CBC Table 11B-208.2; Parking Spaces:

**TRANSACTION COUNTERS ACCESSIBILITY:** At least one of each type of transaction sales and service counter shall be accessible with a counter height of not more than 34 inches above the adjacent ground.

**BLEACHERS ACCESSIBILITY:** Bleachers shall accommodate wheelchair and companion spaces that provide equivalent viewing areas to a person with disabilities. Wheelchair spaces shall be provided in numbers per 2022 CBC table 11B-221.2.1.1:
