EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Established in 1979, the Irvine Sports Committee (Committee) serves as an advisory body reporting to the Community Services Commission. The Committee's purpose is to provide input on the needs of the community pertaining to Irvine's youth sports programs, facilities, and services. The Committee also strives to ensure the equitable allocation of athletic facilities.

The Committee meets quarterly to review field allocations, event calendars, and reservation and allocation policies and procedures. The Tournaments and Events Calendar (Calendar) is attached and presented for the Committee's review, discussion, and input.

ANALYSIS

Tournaments and large events are reserved in accordance with the Athletics Facility Reservation Policy. This Policy provides priorities and methodologies for approving tournaments and large events while meeting the needs of the Irvine community.

The Calendar is created to document tournament and large event requests that extend beyond the activities in the seasonal allocation process. While events remain in the planning process, the Committee reviews the Calendar to ensure facilities are adequate to meet the needs of the event, and the needs of local programs.

For the upcoming Sports Committee meeting in January, I'd like to propose two agenda items. As I am new to this committee, please excuse any lack of experience/incorrectness in protocol for proposing agenda items and I kindly ask for guidance, thank you.

1. Moratorium on additional Sports Committee Members.

Irvine sport fields are occupied by reservations most of the time. As an Irvine resident, I find it difficult to use the fields for walk-on play for my son and friends. At the last Sports Committee meeting, 3 new organizations were added. If more Sports Committee organizations are added again in October 2024, there will be less for Irvine Residents to use in freetime. In addition, in my opinion, more "For-Profit" entities will submit reservation requests in the upcoming years, furthering the impact of field use. I propose a Moratorium on the addition of Sports Committee Organizations (Category "A" only) in order to help balance reservation use and availability for Irvine residents' walk-on use. Although this does not apply with the Sports Committee, I'd like to add ~ I do not propose any limitations to "For-Profit" entity use, for additional reservations in those categories will aid in repairing and restoration of fields for all users.

2. Irvine Reservation System Accounting Software.

The invoicing system for Sports Fields and Facility reservations is confusing. I find it difficult to understand and am unable to receive the details of payments for the Dolphins Organization. I propose a modification to it or upgrades to it in order to allow recipients to receive more detailed information.
