Cicolrvine will highlight the City's commitment to community engagement, sustainability, and environmentally conscious means of travel with nearly two miles of City streets closed to cars and open for people to stroll, bike, and roll along Barranca Parkway and Harvard Avenue.

Engage with attendees and potential customers throughout the day during this great opportunity to reach Irvine residents and visitors. Plan on business as usual, and businesses can become a part of the event by joining Ciclolrvine as an event sponsor or offering specials to visitors the day of the event.



Car Access and Parking

If your business is along the event route, you and your customers may expect some detours, although all commercial parking lots will remain open and accessible at all times.

Street closures will begin at 7 a.m., with full route closures in place by 10 a.m. The event runs 11 a.m.–4 p.m., and streets will be fully open to cars by approximately 6:30 p.m.

Cars can cross the route at all major streets. Streets adjacent to the route will remain open.

Additional parking near the route may be restricted. Check for posted restrictions before the event.
