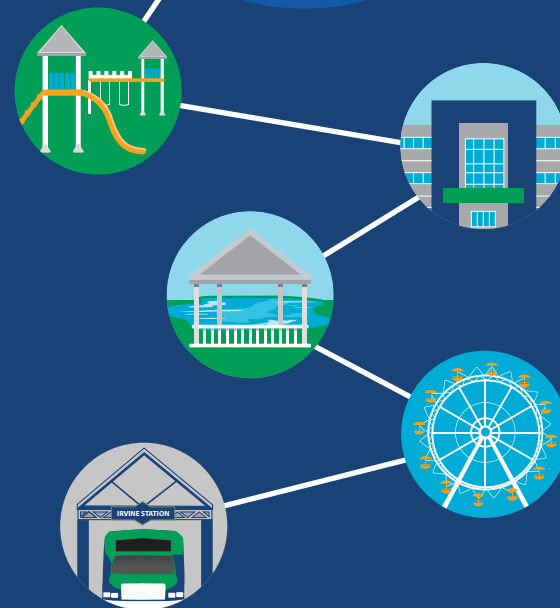




Tips for a Successful Ride

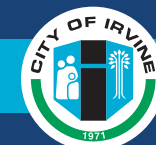
- Arrive at your bus stop at least five minutes before the scheduled departure time.
- Check the destination sign on the front or side of the bus.
- Use the pullcord to signal the driver that you would like to get off at the next stop.
- Store bicycles in the rack on the front of the bus.
- Food and non-alcoholic beverages may be carried on board the bus.
- Free Wi-Fi service onboard.
- Use earbuds with personal audio devices.
- Inform the driver if you need assistance getting on or off the vehicle.
- Please fold strollers before boarding.
- Persons with disabilities may bring service animals on board.
- Small pets are allowed in a pet carrier that can be carried by the rider.

Operating Hours

Weekdays: 6 a.m.–8 p.m.
Weekends: 8 a.m.–10 p.m.

Shuttle frequency is every 20 minutes.

Arrival times are estimates and may fluctuate based on traffic, weather, or ridership volume.

Shuttle service is not available on holidays.
