EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Established in 1979, the Irvine Sports Committee (Committee) serves as an advisory body reporting to the Community Services Commission. The Committee's purpose is to provide input on the needs of the community pertaining to Irvine's youth sports programs, facilities, and services. The Committee also strives to ensure the equitable allocation of athletic facilities.

The Committee meets quarterly to review field allocations, event calendars, and reservation and allocation policies and procedures. The Tournaments and Events Calendar (Calendar) is attached and presented for the Committee's review, discussion, and input.

ANALYSIS

Tournaments and large events are reserved in accordance with the Athletics Facility Reservation Policy. This Policy provides priorities and methodologies for approving tournaments and large events while meeting the needs of the Irvine community.

The Calendar is created to document tournament and large event requests that extend beyond the activities in the seasonal allocation process. While events remain in the planning process, the Committee reviews the Calendar to ensure facilities are adequate to meet the needs of the event, and the needs of local programs.

ALTERNATIVES CONSIDERED

The Committee may request a modification of one or more events.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

Modifications to the Calendar resulting in a reduction of tournament hours may have a financial impact.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

Provide input and recommend Community Services Commission approve an Oak Creek Community Park design option.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

On April 19, 2023, the Community Services Commission (Commission) approved a concept plan for the rehabilitation of Oak Creek Community Park (Park). Among other improvements, the plan included the relocation of an existing full-size soccer field within the Park to accommodate the location of a new dog park. A copy of the approved concept plan is included as Attachment 1.

At the time of approval, the project team specified that the size of the relocated soccer field would remain unchanged. However, as more detailed plans were developed, it was determined that a full-size (i.e., the size of the existing field) soccer field would not be feasible at its new location. As a result, the length of the reconfigured field would be reduced by thirty (30) feet.

An alternative site plan was developed that allows the soccer field to remain in its current location. However, the City has received a mixed response from the community on the alternative plan.

Staff is seeking Irvine Sports Committee (Committee) input and a recommendation to the Commission on the Park design.

ANALYSIS

The approved concept plan for the Park would require the relocation and size reduction of one soccer field. Given the high demand for soccer sites and recent reductions in the City's supply of soccer fields, staff believe reducing the size of the soccer field will exacerbate concerns already expressed by residents and sports groups.

An alternative option was developed to allow the current soccer field locations to remain unchanged. In this scenario, the new dog park would be constructed on the multi-use field at the west side of the park (Attachment 2). Other design options are not feasible since Southern California Edison (SCE) does not permit dog parks on any SCE property.

Community Input on the new Dog Park

While there is strong community support for a dog park at the Park, input is mixed on the new dog park's location within the Park. The alternative dog park design was presented to the Oak Tree Patio Homes Homeowners Association (HOA) for homes located adjacent to the Park. In response, the HOA President expressed strong opposition to the alternative dog park location on either a temporary or a permanent basis.

Subsequent to staff's communication with the HOA, the City received a number of inquiries and comments regarding the proposed location of the dog park. Several residents in the adjacent community indicated that the HOA's opposition to the dog park location was not reflective of a majority of their membership. These residents circulated a petition of support, which has over 1,000 signatures to date.

Staff is seeking the Committee's input regarding the most beneficial solution to this issue and a recommendation to the Commission to direct staff to proceed with the recommended approach.

ALTERNATIVES CONSIDERED

The Committee could recommend the Commission accept the reduced size soccer field or could recommend the Commission support retention of the two full sized fields and construction of the dog park at the west side of the park, as depicted in Attachment 2.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The Oak Creek Community Park Improvements Project has a budget of \$8,688,767. The site layout, as proposed in the approved concept plan, is estimated to cost approximately \$4,115,000. The alternative layout with a dog park located along Valley Oak would cost approximately \$4,015,000. Both scenarios are within the scope of the approved budget.

For the upcoming Sports Committee meeting in January, I'd like to propose two agenda items. As I am new to this committee, please excuse any lack of experience/incorrectness in protocol for proposing agenda items and I kindly ask for guidance, thank you.

1. Moratorium on additional Sports Committee Members.

Irvine sport fields are occupied by reservations most of the time. As an Irvine resident, I find it difficult to use the fields for walk-on play for my son and friends. At the last Sports Committee meeting, 3 new organizations were added.
