Joe Dillman, Public Services Manager, provided updates on scheduled maintenance in the coming months and noted Public Works will continue to work with Community Services on maintaining fields.

Superintendent Stewart then made the following announcements:

- Groups will receive updates regarding the music venue impacts.
- Hicks Canyon batting cages and playground are completed with an official opening date to be determined.
- Bill Barber Park shade structure project is almost completed.
- Las Lomas score boards are set to be updated this year.
- The Oak Creek Park meadow will be the home of a temporary dog park facility with work set to start later.
- Heritage soccer field C will be removed in the design phase.

Committee Member Lemmon noted a USC baseball camp will be taking place at Windrow Park on January 20 and 21, and USC will be playing games at Great Park this season.
