NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that pursuant to § 10224.5 of the Elections Code of the State of California, relating to the General Municipal Election to be held in the City of Irvine on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, the following officers are to be elected:

Mayor – Full term of two (2) years

One (1) Member of the City Council – <u>District 2</u> - Full term of four (4) years

One (1) Member of the City Council – <u>District 3</u> - Full term of four (4) years

One (1) Member of the City Council – <u>District 4</u> - Full term of four (4) years

One (1) Member of the City Council – District 1 - Short term of two (2) years

I, Carl Petersen, City Clerk and Elections Official of the City of Irvine, hereby certify that there are no eligible incumbents for the open office of Mayor due to term limits pursuant to Section 400 of the Irvine City Charter; and no eligible incumbents for the open offices of City Councilmember (Districts 1 through 4) due to the transition from at-large to district-based elections. As such, the nomination period for all open offices will **not** be extended to August 14, 2024.

Completed nomination papers may be filed by appointment only at Irvine City Hall, City Clerk's Office, 1 Civic Center Plaza, Irvine, CA, 92606, between July 15, 2024, and August 9, 2024, and between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday, and 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Fridays.
